USES OF ARTICLES AND PARTS OF SPEECH IN TECHNICAL WRITING

Articles are little words that help English readers determine which specific noun is acting or being acted upon in a sentence. They include words like a, an, and the, as well as possessive words such as his, hers.

PARTS OF SPEECH

- × Noun
- × Verbs
- × Active and passive voice
- × Adjective
- × Adverb
- × Preposition

TECHNICAL WRITING STYLE

- ✘ **Keep the Main Idea on Top** – Place the sentence's main idea, the subject, first. The subject makes the rest of the sentence accessible.
- ✘ **Use Normal Word Order** – This order makes it easier to read as it reveals the topic first and the structures the idea.
- ✘ **Use Active Voice** – Active voice helps the reader follow the meaning quickly as it is sticking to subject-verb-object pattern.
- ✘ **Use Parallelism** – Use similar structures for similar elements.
- ✘ **Avoid Redundancy** – Redundancies are words that say the same content. Conciseness is achieved by saying anything only once.

CHARACTERISTICS OF EFFECTIVE TECHNICAL WRITING

- ✘ **Clear** – easily understood by intended audience
- ✘ **Conciseness** – clear without excess verbiage
- ✘ **Precise** – describing objects and procedures in an exact manner
- ✘ **Skimmable** – easy for readers to scan through the full document and easily find information they need.
- ✘ **Detailed** – Technical writing is very detailed and informative, leaving nothing to the imagination.
